



Enrichment Homework Summer 1 - 2024

Subject: Music

Link to learning: Task A Music Theory - Staff Notation - Treble Clef
Task B Listening and Appraising

For this enrichment homework you can choose either Task A or Task B.

Task A: This task focuses on treble clef note-naming. Please collect a booklet from your Form Tutor, or Ms Esposito and work through each music theory exercise in order, from the beginning.

Expectations - Your answers need to be legible and written in pen. To complete this task on time, you will need to complete around 3 exercise per week.

Task B: You are about to move to a desert island for a 6-month period. You can take 6 pieces of music. What pieces are you going to take and why have you chosen these particular pieces?

Step 1 - Think about the music you like to listen to. It can be from any genre of music. Remember it's all you'll have to listen to for a whole 6 months. Consider when and why you might like to listen to each piece. Music can be vocal and/or instrumental and/or both. Decide on 6 tracks.

Step 2 - Start your presentation. You will be writing 6 paragraphs over the course of 5 weeks. Each paragraph must contain the title of the piece, the composer/writer and the person/group who is/are performing it. Each of the six paragraphs must contain, most importantly, the reasons why you have decided to take this particular piece.

Expectations - Your work needs to be tidy, legible and written in pen. It will be presented on one or two sheets of A4. It can be handwritten or typed. Pay close attention to spelling, punctuation and grammar.
