Letters for end of year trips are being given out so please could we ask these be brought back in as soon as possible.

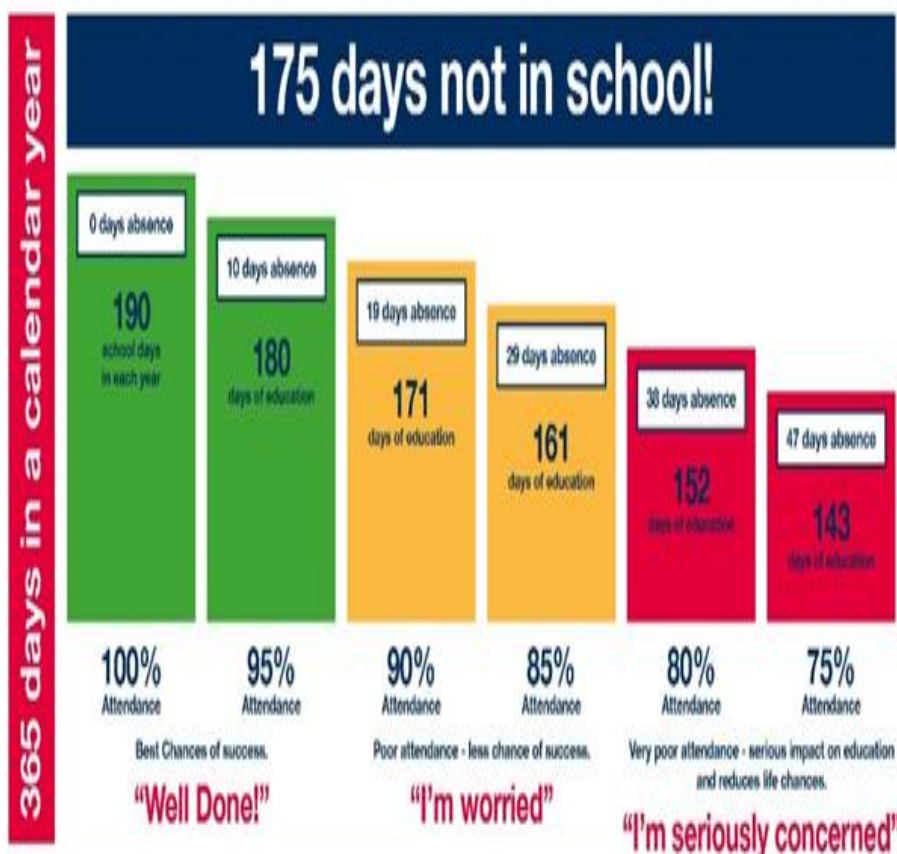

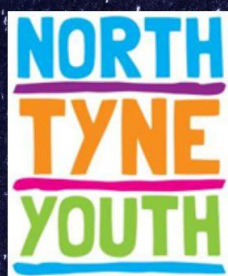

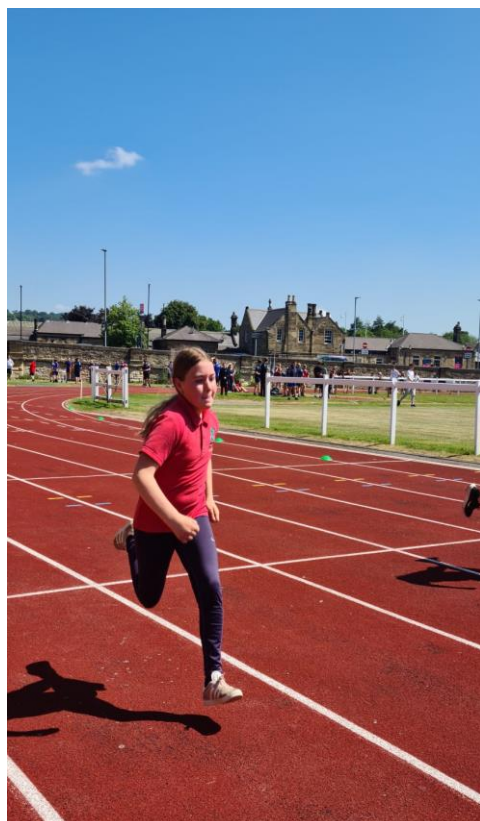
## Virtual Author Visit
